

# Cut-Off

The name [Cut-Off](#) is related to the tradition to have the player on the right to the [dealer](#) cut the card deck after the [dealer](#) shuffled it.

In games where the player are taking turns in dealing, the person on their immediate right has the right to cut the deck once the [dealer](#) finished the shuffle.

The short-term used for the [Cut-Off](#) is [CO](#).

As the [Cut-Off](#) is considered one of the most premium positions in poker next to the [button](#), players are able to play more cards than in earlier positions.
